## **News Story of the week**



Ahead of World Environment Day on 5th June, a new report from the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) has announced that countries could cut plastic pollution by 80% in fewer than 20 years. The last few decades have seen plastic production levels increase dramatically, especially single-use plastic, and waste management systems are struggling to cope. The report offers a plan of action for governments and businesses to significantly cut levels of plastic pollution.

#### **Chemistry with Cabbage**

Year 6 had the brilliant opportunity to take part in Chemistry with Cabbage. Our chemist was blown away by them being able to answer questions that are normally asked at A-Level. They experimented with acids and alkalis making their own indicator from red cabbage water. They learnt how to neutralise both or change one into the other. They learnt how to make medicines to help with stomach acid and how those medicines work. We were so impressed by how hard they worked; we seemingly have many budding scientists in this year 6 class.
