Within the next ten years, people may be able to travel between London and Sydney in just two hours by journeying through space on a sub-orbital flight. The current length of a traditional flight between London, UK, and Sydney, Australia, is at least 20-22 hours and usually entails a stop-off to refuel along the way. A sub-orbital flight involves launching a spacecraft to an altitude above the Kármán line (the boundary of space).

Attendance

May I ask that all Parents and Carers take the time to review our Attendance Policy which can be found on our school website and a copy is also attached. We are seeing an increased number of children being late for school and also requests for term time absence. As a reminder:


- The school gates open at 8.45am. The gates will be locked promptly at 8.50am. The register closes at 8.55am. Please ensure your child is ready to come into school at 8.45am so they can register and prepare themselves for the day. This avoids disruption to classmates and lessons.
- Term time holidays will only be permitted in exceptional circumstances. We are seeing an increase of last minute requests sometimes on the day or parents turning up to take their children. A fixed penalty notice may be issued by the Local Authority as follows:
- 10 unauthorised consecutive absent sessions due to a family holiday.
- Where persistence absence is recorded as unauthorised
- ⇒ The current rates payable by parents are £60 where the amount is paid within 21 days and £120 where the amount is paid within 21-28 days. This charge is per parent/carer per child. If the fixed penalty notice remains unpaid this could lead to prosecution in the Magistrate's Court.
